Submitting a Nomination

The nominee should submit the following five (5) components of the nomination to the OB-PS staff:

1. **Part A** - Completed by the nominee
2. **Part B** - Two (2) statements of support from OB-PS Members
3. **Curriculum Vitae (CV)** – Provide details of current and past roles you have held within charitable or non-profit organisations, as well as professional, NGO, or business appointments.
4. **Photograph** – A recent image, taken within the last six months. The photo should be portrait style, facing the camera. JPEG, PNG, and TIFF formats are accepted.
5. **Video** – A short video (up to 3 minutes) introducing yourself and outlining your motivation for joining the Board (video details below).

Please send all materials by email to inga.pikse@waggs.org no later than **23:59 (UTC) on 30 November 2025**. Incomplete or late submissions will **not** be considered. If you have any questions about completing or submitting your nomination, please contact inga.pikse@waggs.org.

Videos

As part of the nomination process, please submit a short video of yourself, no longer than three (3) minutes in length.

This video is not expected to be professional or polished—it is simply an opportunity for the OB-PS Board to get to know you better. We would like to hear, in your own words:

- Who you are (please begin with your name and country).
- Why you would like to become a member of the OB-PS Board.
- What you hope to contribute.

Your video will be shared with OB-PS Board Members as a personal introduction and a chance for them to connect with you beyond the written nomination.

Format and Submission: We can accept a wide variety of formats including MP4, WMV, MOV, AVI, etc. You can send your video as an attachment in an email with your nominations form. However, if the file size of your video is larger than 10MB you may find it easier to send your video by WeTransfer (a free online service for sending large files), Dropbox or Google Drive.
