We reflect on 2022 with deep gratitude. On May 29th, three hundred people gathered at Gail Dady's majestic Caliburn Farm to attend the inaugural Eagle Cafe presented by Thomas J. Campbell and Barbara & David Roux. With over two hundred new supporters in attendance, we raised a record \$1.2 million for our programs serving the U.S. Special Operations Forces (SOF) and Gold Star communities. Those gifts had an immediate impact.


In 2022, our virtual and in-person programs in Montana, Virginia Beach, and San Diego served 484 SOF families - operators, spouses, children, and Gold Star children - with two-thirds of the participating families returning home to continue serving on active duty. Nearly 150 families attended our programs at Base Camp Jimmy in Montana! No participant pays anything to attend our programs, anywhere or anytime. Sponsors and our guests at the Eagle Cafe provide the funding that allows the Special Operations and Gold Star communities to attend our programs and experience a true homecoming from war.

We ask you to join us on Saturday, June 3rd for the second Eagle Cafe, hosted by Barbara Roux, Gail Dady, and the planning committee at the Roux's St. Bride's Farm in Upperville, VA. Our goal for 2023 is to raise \$1.5 million, which will expand our staff and programs in Virginia Beach and San Diego, add programs for the first time at Fort Bragg and Camp Leieune, North Carolina, strengthen our core program and training team in Montana, and exclusively fund programs, including our RESTORE and Spouse Performance programs and workshops.

We greatly appreciate your trust and support in delivering on the nation's promise to be there when our warriors come home.
