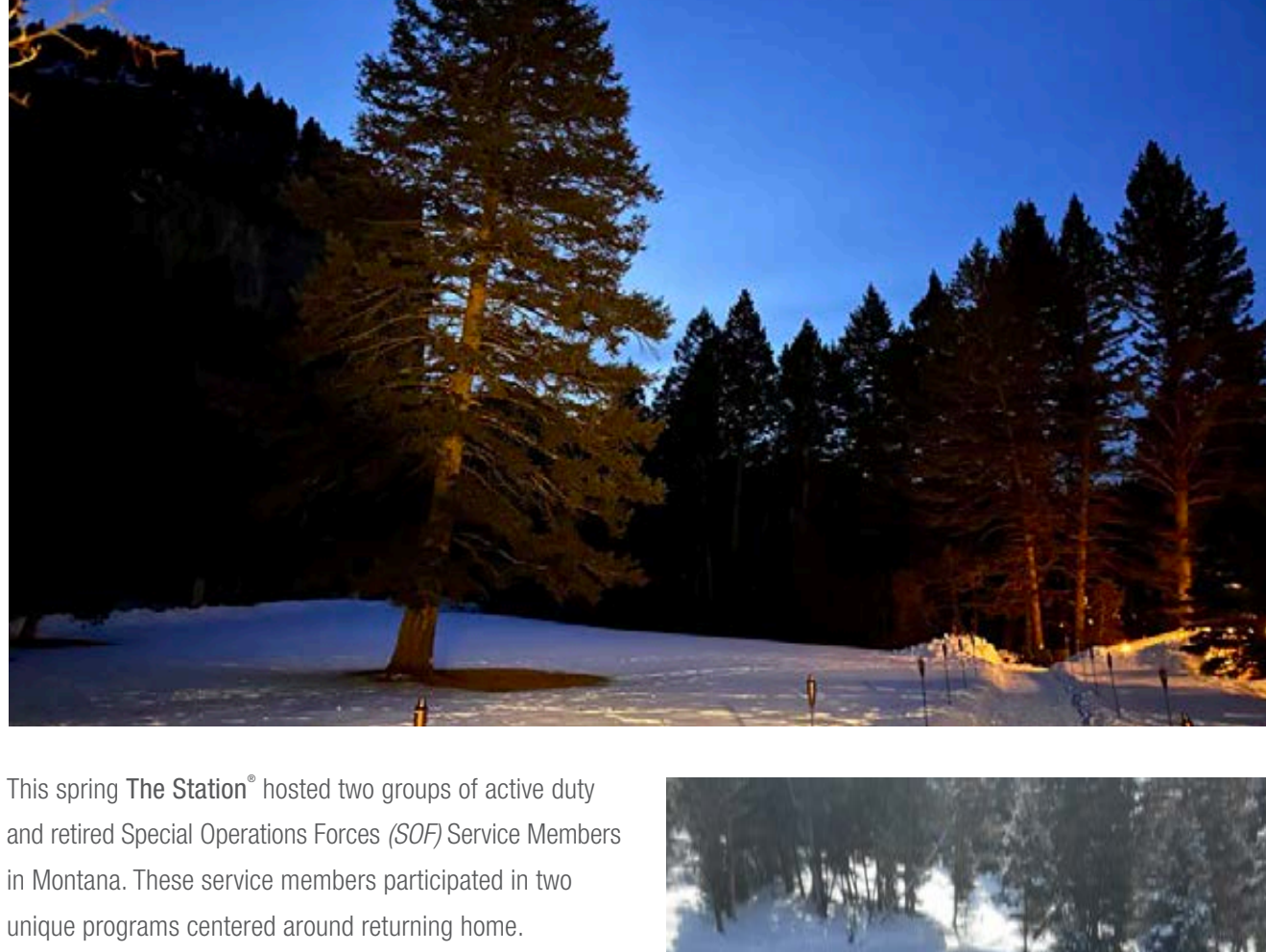

DETAILS Transition Azimuth Check (TrAC) and The Return



This spring The Station® hosted two groups of active duty and retired Special Operations Forces (SOF) Service Members in Montana. These service members participated in two unique programs centered around returning home.

In March, our Transition Azimuth Check (TrAC) program walked participants through a life of service and assisted them as they navigate difficult decisions surrounding transition. TrAC is intentionally curated to make a meaningful impact in the service members' personal lives, families' lives, and communities. Through a mix of outdoor experiences, conversations, and guided processes, (see TrAC video) participants discovered pathways towards healthy transition and purpose beyond uniform.



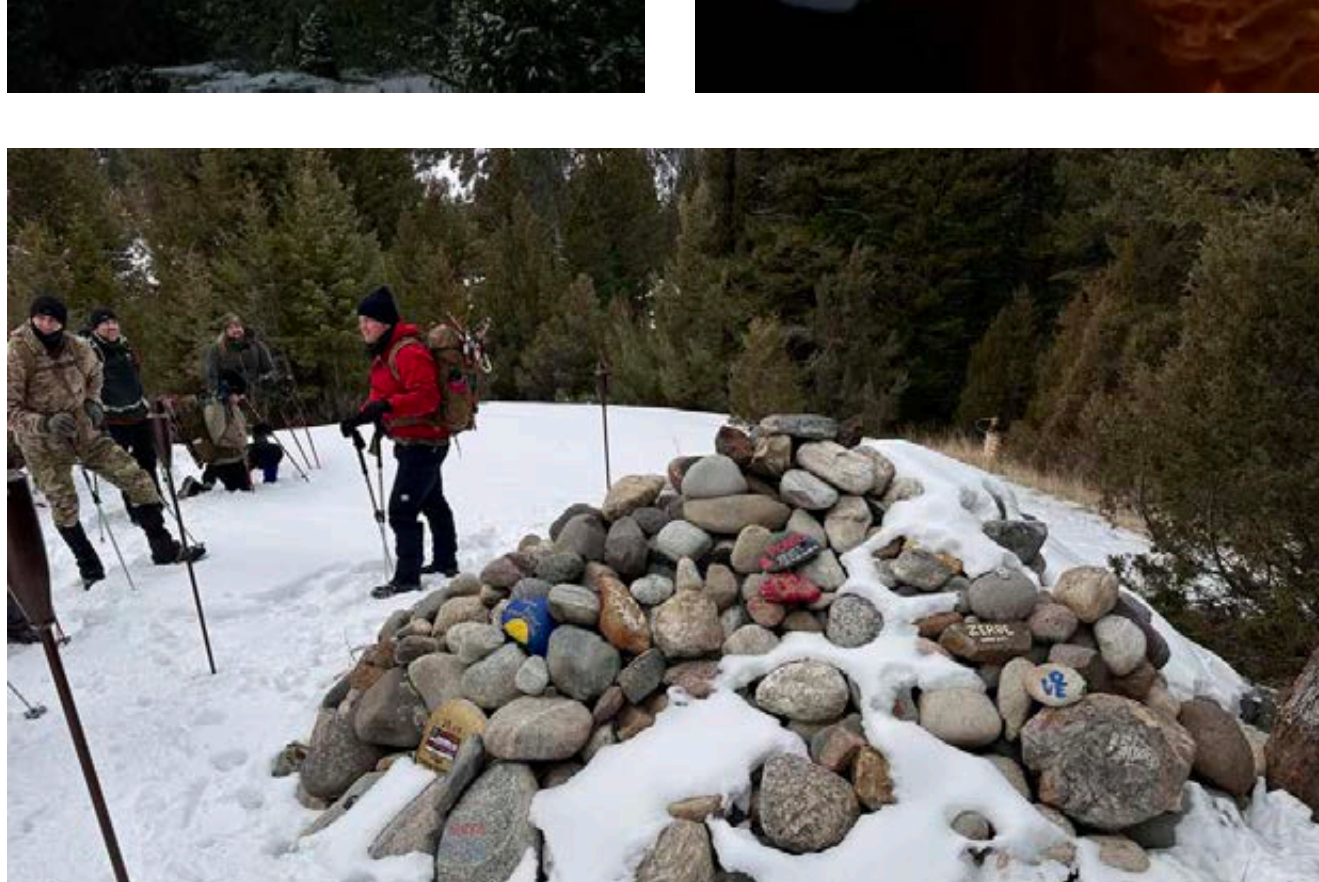
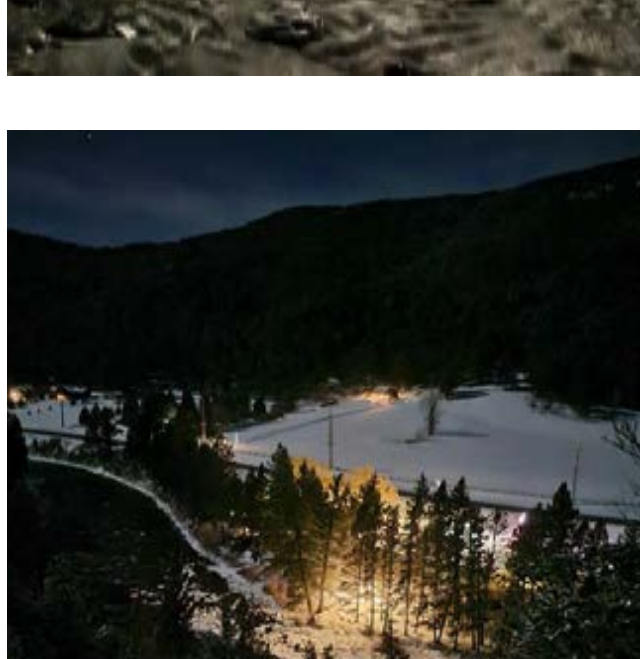
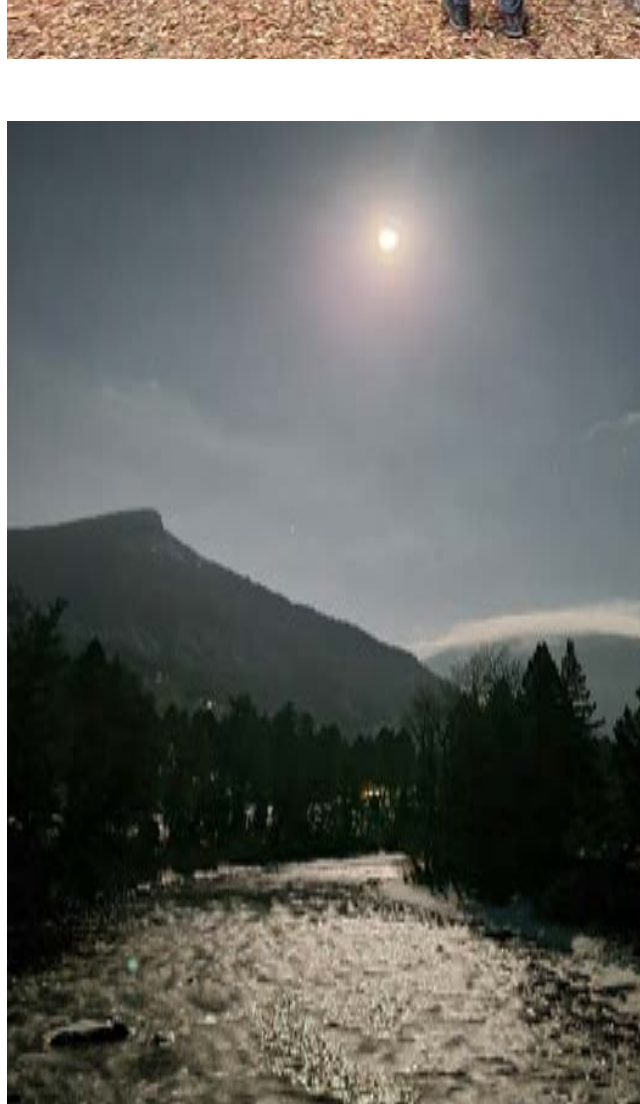

In late April through early May, The RETURN program guided service members through a nine-day Hero's Journey, exploring the way of the warrior and its significance beyond the battlefield.

In the unique way that Base Camp Jimmy offers, participants disconnected from the distractions of everyday life and moved into the stillness of sacred space. With strength and courage, they dropped into powerful rites of passage. Each ritual helped our modern day warriors heal, grow, and reconnect with their ancestral roots.

As a tribe they shared and considered how serving as a warrior extends beyond war and deep into SOF families, service members' relationships, and their commitment to live with honor. Participants completed their journey through a homecoming ceremony steeped in sacred tradition.
