Apple

1:1 match up to \$10,000

- Employees/donors should register their matching gift requests along with an electronic receipt electronically at https://apple.benevity.org/user/login.
- Employees should submit their matching gift requests within 1 month of the donation date.

AMD

1:1 matches from \$25 to \$1,500

- Employees/donors should submit their match request electronically at https://amd.benevity.org/
- AMD matches employees' contributions of money (Matching Gifts) and time (GIVE-Grant Incentives for Volunteer Efforts) to approved nonprofit organizations and schools up to \$3,000 per year (combined program cap) per employee.
- An employee could reach his or her cap entirely through contributions (\$3,000 USD) or volunteer service (max 200 hours)--or through a combination of the two programs.

AT&T

0.5 to 1 match up to \$500

 While on the company intranet, employees should complete their donation and match request electronically at https://att.benevity.org/

Bank of America

- Associates submit matching gift requests electronically by logging in at https://www.cybergrants.com/boa/branch.html.
- Associates can submit their gifts until March 31st of the year following their donation.

Dell

- Dell matches individual donations (all global employees)
- Dell matches the portion of an employee's fundraising effort that comes from Dell colleagues for events such as charity walks, runs, and bikes.
- In order to get their donation's matched, employees/donors should donate or fundraise directly through Dell's giving portal at https://dell.benevity.org/user/login. To access the site, employees should be logged into the company intranet using their Single Sign On credentials or enter their username & password.
- Note: Dell only matches donations made by spouses if it's recorded as a joint donation made by the employee as well.

Google

1:1 match up to \$1000

- Employees should search the company intranet for matching gifts while connected to the company intranet to locate the most up to date electronic submission link. Alternatively, Employees should submit their requests electronically at https://google.benevity.org/user/login.
- Matching gift requests must be submitted by January 31st of the year following the date of the donation.

Hilton

1:1 match up to \$500

 While on the company intranet, employees should submit their requests electronically at https://hosthotels.benevity.org/user/login. All donations made through the online giving system are automatically matched.

IBM

1:1 matches from \$25 to \$10,000

• IBM employees should submit their matching gift requests electronically at https://ibm.benevity.org/user/login.

Intel

1:1 matches from \$10 to \$10,00

- Each eligible Intel participant will be able to generate an Intel Foundation match of up to \$10,000* each calendar year for donations to eligible charitable organizations and eligible education institutions.
- There are two categories of giving within the annual maximum of \$10,000 for U.S. & retirees:
 - 1. My Personal Choice: Donate up to \$2,000 to any eligible cause (nonprofit or school) of your personal choice and have it matched in the Benevity system.
 - 2. Community Impact: Donate up to \$8,000 to curated causes supporting STEAM Education, Community, Workforce Development, Sustainability, and Tech for Good and have it matched in the Benevity system.

JP Morgan Chase

 Employees should submit their matching gift requests electronically at https://www.cybergrants.com/jpmc/giving/. Funds will be put into the CSA where they can be allocated to firm approved eligible organizations. Microsoft

1:1 match up to \$15,000

- Employees / donors can submit their matching gift requests electronically at https://microsoft.benevity.org/user/login.
- Donors can submit match requests for donations made at any point in the last 12 months.

National Instruments

1:1 matches from \$25 to \$1,000

- While on the company intranet, employees/donors should register their matching gift requests electronically through the company's internal giving platform.
- Employees can submit match requests for donations made at any point during the last 12 months.

Paypal

1:1 match ranging from \$10 up to \$2,500

- Employees / donors should register their matching gift requests electronically at https://paypal.benevity.org/user/login.
- Employees are requested to submit match requests in a timely manner since there is a company-wide annual limit that could be reached.
- Upon submission, the nonprofit will be notified and asked to verify and claim the donation.

Salesforce

1:1 up to \$5,000

- While on the company intranet, employees should submit their matching gift requests electronically at https://salesforce.benevity.org/user/login.
- Receipt must be provided and matching request must be submitted within 60 days

Samsung

1:1 matches \$25 to \$2.000

• Employees should submit their matches electronically at https://samsung.benevity.org/user/login.

State Farm Insurance

1:1 matches from \$25 to \$4,500

• Employees should log into https://www.cybergrants.com/pls/cybergrants/eg_login.login?x_gm_id=4214 to submit their matching gift requests electronically. Paper forms are no longer available accepted.

Vista Equity Partners

1:1 matches ranging from \$25 up to \$2,500

• While on the company intranet, employees should submit their matching gift requests electronically at https://www.cybergrants.com/vista/.

Wells Fargo Bank

1:1 match up to \$2,000

 In order to get their donation's matched, employees/donors should donate through Wells Fargo's giving portal at https://wellsfargo.yourcause.com/. Employees should be logged into the company intranet using their Single Sign On credentials or enter their username & password
