Reconciliation



ADORATION -

"For He Himself is our peace, who has made us both one and has broken down in His flesh the dividing wall of hostility...that He might create in Himself one new man in place of the two, so making peace, and might reconcile us both to God in one body through the cross, thereby killing the hostility." Ephesians 2:14-17, ESV

- Praise God for His magnificent purpose to create in Himself one new humanity!
- Worship Him as the one true God of reconciliation and redemption.
- Ask God to search your heart of any unforgiveness, bitterness or resentment so as not to hinder your prayers. (See Psalm 139:23-24, Matt 5:23-26, Mark 11:25, and Eph 1:3-10)



INTERCESSION

"All this is from God, who reconciled us to Himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: that God was reconciling the world to Himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them. And He has committed to us the message of reconciliation." 2 Cor 5:18-19 NIV

- Pray for God to bind up broken hearts with the issues of racism and injustice. Pray for
 godly reconciliation to be forged as believers seek authentic relationships with those
 different from them, breaking down the walls of hostility between disperate groups.
- Ask God for supernatural healing, forgiveness and genuine reconciliation in the body.
- Pray for God to break down divisions between primarily white and black churches as well as congregations of different ethnicities. May we stand together, endure, and persevere together with grace and forgiveness. (See John 13:34, 1 Cor 12:13, & Rev 7:9)
