



A Continuing Cultural Education Program for Pastors and Church Leaders

The **Minnery Fellowship for Cultural Engagement** is an ongoing Continuing Cultural Education program to provide opportunities for pastors and elders to dive into the practical issues facing Christians in culture and develop, with a cohort of their peers, biblical strategies and messages to respond.

The Cleveland Cohort will begin monthly meetings on Friday, January 31, from 12:00 to 2:00 pm, at the Union Club in Cleveland. The deadline to apply for the Minnery Fellowship Cleveland cohort is Tuesday, December 31.



Pastor Austin Shaw, of Providence Church in Avon, will serve as the Cleveland cohort facilitator. He received his theological education in England, earning a master's degree and a PhD in Church History from the University of Oxford, and holds a fellowship in the Center for Pastor Theologians, a group of church leaders committed to the interface of theology and local church ministry.

How much does the Minnery Fellowship cost?

How much time is required?

Participants should plan to invest two hours per month to attend the cohort meeting, plus approximately 15 minutes per day of self-study.

The Spring 2025 session will focus on Biblical Cultural Engagement utilizing select chapters of Biblical Critical Theory by Dr. Christopher Watkin.
