The **Minnery Fellowship for Cultural Engagement** is an ongoing Continuing Cultural Education program to provide opportunities for pastors and elders to dive into the practical issues facing Christians in culture and develop, with a cohort of their peers, biblical strategies and messages to respond.

Pastor Blair Hayward, of Living Hope Church in Findlay, will serve as the Northwest Ohio cohort facilitator. He received a Masters in Divinity with an emphasis in Evangelism from Trinity Evangelical Divinity School. After serving as an Associate Pastor for seven years in St. Joseph, Michigan, Blair has been privileged to serve as Senior Pastor at Living Hope Church since 2010.

How much time is required?

Participants should plan to invest two hours per month to attend the cohort meeting, plus approximately 15 minutes per day of self-study.
